Historical Items of Interest
1995

- January 31, 1995
- ACSEC and 9-1-1 public educators search for name for character for video. Reddy Fox is ruled out. A 'Name the Fox' contest to be held in schools statewide.
 - ACSEC request photos of children who have successfully called 9-1-1. With permission from parents, children's pictures to be place in the video.
 - **Phone Book Standardization was presented using the TDD/TTY symbol on the front two pages. GTE and SWB agreed to use format that was presented to them.** Phone companies will want to use Council of Government (COG) and 9-1-1 DISTRICT contact to verify seven-digit non-emergency telephone numbers.
 - **PETS voted that participation in the 9-1-1 Public Educators of Texas would be limited to Council of Governments, Districts and Home Rule Cities. That vendor participation was more appropriate at state/national conferences and not at PET workshops.**
 - Allocation formula for receiving products from ACSEC would be based on population.
 - A registration fee for workshops of \$15-\$20 should be considered.
- April 4, 1995
- \$15.00 registration fee for meeting was imposed to offset cost of quarterly meetings.
 - TAG Team started in North Central Texas Council of Governments.
 - 9-1-1 Phone Simulators developed and used in many areas.
 - Resource sheet presented as a means to share with others.
- July 13, 1995
- Mary Boyd helps in licensing agreement with 9-1-1 mascot.
 - First order period from ACSEC was in June, 1995. After the first round of ordering, orders will be taken quarterly.
 - Cellular Phone project discussed.
- December 4, 1995
- Final review of draft of script for 'The Great 9-1-1 Adventure' video. The video will be taped week of December 11, 1995.
